

EMJ.LIFE Publishes Corrected EMJ.NEXUS Governance Documentation v1.2

The revised GDAP collection corrects the annual IPP and E-IPP Points reset rules while preserving the same canonical landing page and one Institutional Registry record.

Why version 1.2 was issued promptly

SINGAPORE, 21 September 2026 - EMJ LIFE HOLDINGS PTE. LTD. has issued version 1.2 of the EMJ.NEXUS Governance Documentation Advance Publication after identifying that version 1.1 did not completely state the intended annual reset rules for IPP Points and E-IPP Points.

The correction is substantive because Points determine task-claim capacity. Version 1.2 therefore replaces the six v1.1 operational manuals with six corrected v1.2 manuals and states the controlling formulas without ambiguity. IPP Score and E-IPP Score remain cumulative and do not reset.

Version 1.2 is the current version of the existing GDAP publication record. It does not create a thirtieth EMJ.LIFE Institutional Registry record. The Registry continues to contain 29 publication records. Version 1.1 remains represented only through the record metadata JSON and the Full Registry JSON as version-history metadata.

The canonical landing page is unchanged so institutional and machine retrieval continue to resolve to one controlled GDAP record.

Correct annual Points rules

Individual IPP Points

At each annual platform cycle, the IPP Points balance resets to whichever is higher: 170 IPP Points or 10% of the balance immediately before reset. The 10% alternative is capped at 500 IPP Points.

Formula: $\max(170, \min(10\% \text{ of the pre-reset IPP Points balance}, 500))$.

Enterprise E-IPP Points

At each annual platform cycle, the E-IPP Points balance resets to whichever is higher: 200 E-IPP Points or 10% of the balance immediately before reset. The 10% alternative is capped at 500 E-IPP Points.

Formula: $\max(200, \min(10\% \text{ of the pre-reset E-IPP Points balance}, 500))$.

IPP Score and E-IPP Score do not reset. They continue to accumulate as the individual's or enterprise's verified participation record.

Identity, task and access routes

Students, employees and consumers

Students, employees and consumers use www.sdgspass.com and select Personal. A student registers with a university-issued email address. Employees and consumers register with an individual email address. Each person receives one lifelong UID.

Schools and universities

Schools and universities use www.edu-sdgspass.org. During the first invitation phase, an invited institution must match its WHED ID and invited institutional email address before receiving a School EGC ID and the right to issue 24 controlled school-exclusive task types.

A student provides the personal UID and required verification information to the school. The school must approve the binding before the student can claim school-exclusive tasks.

Points and task execution

Completing all 17 SDG assessments creates the one-time allocation of 170 IPP Points and 170 IPP Score. Claiming a task with requirement T deducts T Points. Verified approval awards 2T Points and adds T Score.

After the applicable enterprise activation conditions are completed, an enterprise begins with 200 E-IPP Points and an E-IPP Score of 0. A supply-chain task claim deducts T E-IPP Points. Verified approval awards 2T E-IPP Points and adds T E-IPP Score.

Publication does not activate every function. Each function becomes available only in its announced phase and after the applicable identity, eligibility, payment and operational checks are complete.
